

## **PE and Sport Grant Allocation**

The DfE have stated that by 4 April 2014 maintained schools and academies must publish information on their website about how they have used the PE and Sport Grant allocation, including how it has (or will be spent) and the impact it is having.

Watford Grammar School for Boys has received £4,433 in November 2012 and £3,167 for the Sports Grant.

This money has been put towards paying the salary of Alistair Dawson, a new teacher hired by the school this academic year. He provides daily specialist support in the local primary school, Chater. He offers sports such as Tag Rugby, Hockey, Cricket, Basketball, Tennis and Athletics.

He is also in contact with two other primary schools, Nascot Wood and Casiobury. They are invited, along with Chater, to at least one Primary Schools Festival every half term. Here over 180 children take part in a morning of competitive sport against one another. We target all age groups (Y3-6) at the festivals.

He is supported at the events by our junior sports ambassadors. This gives about 50 of our most talented boys the opportunity to develop skills outside of the classroom and off the sports field.

This additional work in supporting and progressing the uptake and development of sports in young people in the local area has been highly successful and thus the sports grant funding will continue to be spent in this way for the foreseeable future.
