## Sports development campaign hits halfway mark

Welcome to a special edition of Fuller News.

Now that we have reached the halfway point in our Sports Development Campaign, we wanted to update you on the appeal.

As always, we have been overwhelmed by the generosity of our alumni in your ongoing support for the school. Thanks to your kind donations, our campaign to raise £100,000 towards the new astroturf pitch has got off to a strong start.

As we outlined in the last edition of *Fuller News*, our current astroturf pitch is in a poor condition and no longer fit for purpose. A new, extended pitch will provide our pupils with much-needed improved sports facilities – and extra space to play at break times - on the main school site.

We know that many of our alumni have very happy memories of participating in sports during their time here and would like to ensure the same opportunities are available for current and future pupils of the school. Having the visible support of WBGs alumni in this campaign will serve as a powerful reminder of the importance of one generation helping the next.
