

Psychology at A-level Home Learning

- All work is put on Google Classroom with detailed instructions and resources. Work for each week will be posted on Monday morning.
- There is a dedicated Home Learning Instructions section on Google Classroom where all work instructions and resources can be found. Resources can also be found under the relevant topic section.
- Students will be set 4 x 1 hour lessons to be completed at the time they would normally have Psychology lessons. This will help students organise their time.
- Students must complete their work on a Google/Word doc according to the deadline given by their teacher. Any student who has a problem in meeting a deadline should email Mr McGinty in advance McGintya@watfordboys.org
- Students should expect written comments as feedback from Mr McGinty.
- Students will need to have constant access to their textbooks and Google Classroom resources.
- Students must use their allocated 5th hour for wider reading. Suggestions for this will be set on Google Classroom.

- Students will be set exam questions where they should expect feedback based on OCR exam criteria.
- Students will have an allocated week for Psychology progress review tasks. During that week, I expect students to
